SPECIAL NOTES:

SAILING RESUME: Completion of a Moorings Sailing Resume is compulsory for all "First-Time" bareboat charters at ALL bases.

SAILING LICENSES: are required at the following Med destinations – Greece, Turkey, Croatia. The client should submit the following *(except for Croatia where a valid license is required)*:

- A PDF copy of the license to the booking locations and take the original copy of the license with him/her to the base.
- In the event a client does not have a Sailing/Nautical License, the base will produce a document (equivalent to a sailing license) which will be given to the client upon arrival.

To produce this document, the following needs to be send to the booking location (30 days in advance):

- Copy of Passport (or name, date of birth, nationality)
- Address

GREECE: Two Sailing licenses/Certificates (or Nautical Licenses) are required OR one sailing license (skipper) and the declaration of honour signed (crew)

CROATIA: A recognized Sailing license/Certificate (or Nautical License) is required.

TURKEY: A Sailing license/Certificate (or Nautical License) is required.

SEYCHELLES: Sailing resume OR sailing license is required

ITALY: Clients, that live in a country that does NOT require a sailing license when operating a recreational vessel, are not required to provide a sailing license if they can provide written documentation stating that a license is not required in their country, signed by a sailing authority and they need to proof their sailing experience – log book, etc.

MEXICO: All Mexican nationals are required to obtain a sailing license issued by the Ministry of the Navy prior to being able to charter from our base in Baja. In order to get this license, the client will need to take a course as well as a medical exam. Upon completion of the course and medical exam it takes approximately two weeks for the license to be issued.
